### Dannevirke Golf Course

This course is extremely well regarded for its high level of maintenance and it's scenic holes. You will enjoy great views of the Ruahine Ranges behind you, whilst finding that every hole you play is perfectly unique and offers its own challenge.

Warm up on the handy practice green close to the clubrooms (have a laugh hearing the locals shouting instructions to each other - not many are appreciated!) Once on the course you will be pleased to find very little rough on any part of the course. You'll enjoy a great game of golf in a blissful haven of green surroundings.

There is friendly country hospitality to be found, at the café and bar before and after your round. "The 19th hole" offers views of the entire course, so you can relax and watch everyone else play. It's a warm, bright venue and everyone there will be pleased to meet you!

The Golf Club Campsite is a very popular place to stay overnight. Bathroom and toilet facilities are available. This is a secure area with security checks and a locked gate during the night. Cost is a mere \$10 per night, per site! Bring your tent, motorhome or caravan and enjoy the serenity.

### Eketahuna Golf Course

For a small town, Eketahuna packs a punch. From the moment you drive into town to the moment you step onto the green, Eketahuna promises to impress. The Golf Course itself is a great source of pride for its members. It's just the place to stop and enjoy some pure fresh air before heading forward on your journey.

You will laugh when you see the "groundstaff" at Eketahuna Golf Course. They are short, woolly and have four legs! That's right, the local sheep keep the grass down and fertilize the course.
